

# HOW TO BIND A BOGGART

**Boggarts move up and down ley lines but can be trapped in one place.**

**This is called naturally bound Some think the lines are ancient paths**

**used by forefathers in ancient times but they're really lines of**

**power underground. Invisible roads that some boggarts use to**

**travel quickly from place to place. Earthquakes can trap boggarts**

**and make them naturally bound, unable to move more than a dozen**

**paces in any direction. Most best left where they are.**

**If in awkward spot (near house or road), need to be moved away and**

**artificially bound as follows:**

**Pit needs to be dug at least six feet deep. For rippers, nine feet.**

**Pit must be coated with mixture of salt and iron mixed into a bone glue.**

**Salt burns a boggart. Iron bleeds away its strength.**

**Blood placed in pit to lure boggart into it before stone is dropped into place,**

**sealing it underground.**

**Don't forget to coat inside of stone!**
